### BILL'S MESSAGE

Dear friends at Shepherd of the Lakes,

From little on I have always enjoyed watching the change of the seasons, and it is one of the things I love most about where we live. As the days lengthen and warm, we witness the wonders of spring, where all that laid dark and dormant, seemingly overnight, comes to life.

On Ash Wednesday we began our Lenten journey once again with Jesus and his disciples. Jesus' ministry begins in a spiritually dark and dormant world. People living with little or no hope, no joy, no light in their life. As we walked with Jesus, we experienced as the people and disciples did, his message of hope and love, the miracles he performed to build faith, and the gift of faith that many received. He proclaimed himself to be the light of the world, a light that no darkness can overcome, and that he would bring light and life to the dark and dormant place of our hearts. But before we can celebrate the light and life of the risen Christ, we must once more walk with Jesus through the darkness of Gethsemane, Golgotha, and the tomb, and in doing so, confronting our fears, our own dark places.

I invite you to come and be a part once again of these powerful services, this wonderful story of love and sacrifice, and to celebrate the final victory, the resurrection of our Lord... the light that could not and cannot be overcome, the light that brings life to all things dark and dormant.
